Keynote Luncheon Speaker

Cat Thao Nguyen, Vietnam

Cat Thao Nguyen is the Managing Director of Global Ready LLC and Lumina Learning Partner,

helping organisations and individuals lead inclusively in a globalised world. Born in a refugee camp in Thailand and arriving in Australia in 1980, Cat Thao's memoir, *We Are Here*, tells the powerful story of her family's escape from Vietnam across the Cambodian Killing Fields and their life as new migrants in Australia.

With a diverse career spanning corporate law, private equity, and international education, Cat Thao is a trailblazer. She has played a pivotal role in strengthening trade, cooperation, and cultural ties between Vietnam and Australia and co-founded the Australia Vietnam Young Leadership Dialogue, uniting leaders from both countries to advance sustainability and social justice. Cat Thao was the first Asian-Australian Youth Representative to the United Nations General Assembly and the first Vietnamese-certified advisor by the Cultural Intelligence Center (USA).

Breaking the Silence: Integrating Death, Dying and Bereavement Education into Schools

John Adams is a fourth-generation funeral director, respected podcast host, and dedicated advocate for incorporating death, dying, and bereavement education into the UK national curriculum. His efforts have sparked national attention, leading to a parliamentary debate on the topic. John has held notable roles, including serving as an advisor to Child Bereavement UK and as an Ambassador for the Good Grief Trust. As a Past President of the UK's National Association of Funeral Directors, John is a prominent voice in the funeral industry, aiming to foster open conversations about death and grief. In his presentation, John will discuss the importance of death education, the progress of his campaign for legislative change, and the role of funeral professionals in supporting these vital conversations.

Cu Chi Tunnels

Embark on a journey to the Cu Chi area, once the operational base for Vietcong guerillas who played a pivotal role during the war. Witness the hand-dug tunnels, initially excavated during the 1940s French occupation and later expanded in the 1960s. These tunnels were lifelines during the war, serving as hideouts, supply routes, and communication channels. This 120km network endures as a profound war memorial.
